A project developed to bring clean water to the most deprived communities?, Water For Life shows the initiative undertaken by Humanity First in conjunction with the International Association of Ahmadi Architects & Engineers to provide water filtration systems?, hand pumps and wells to overlooked remote villages in the world?.



### **SERVING HUMANITY**

### TAHIR HEART INSTITUTE



Take a look at one of the state-of-the-art hospitals in Rabwah, Pakistan; dedicated to serving humanity – regardless of caste or religion<sup>6</sup>, problems which are prevalent in Pakistan. The six-story cardiac institute provides a range of cardiac care such as open heart surgery, full cardiac support services and angiography / angioplasty treatment<sup>6</sup>, and was built in response to the rampant poverty and lack of affordable medical care in Pakistan.<sup>6</sup> Tahir Heart Institute also includes a research center<sup>6</sup>, serving the needs of each individual with special concern for those who are sick or poor.<sup>6</sup>

### FEATURE FILM: SERVING HUMANITY IN GUATEMALA



Viewers are given a behind the scenes look at the development and inauguration of the new Nasir Hospital in Sacatepéquez, Guatemala. Through the efforts of Humanity First, the state-of-the-art facility has meant that residents are now given equitable access to health care. The Humanity First hospital utilizes the skills local physicians, nurses, and administrators aided by an international volunteer base of more than 400 physicians, in order to bring quality care to the community. The hospital was opened during His Holiness's first visit to the country in October 2018.
